



A CALL TO LACCEI DEANS TO PARTICIPATE

MEETING OF DEANS AND DEANS OF ENGINEERING OF LATAM AND THE CARIBBEAN OF LACCEI

Eng. Miguel Angel Sosa, Associate Vice President of the Council of Deans of LACCEI, will convene the Face-to-Face Meeting of Deans and Deans of Engineering of ALyC of LACCEI.

This initial meeting is scheduled for May 30 through June 1, 2022, at the UNIVERSIDAD TECNOLÓGICA DE HONDURAS in San Pedro Sula, Honduras. This meeting will be a precursor to the corresponding First Face-to-Face Meeting of the Council of Deans and Deans of Engineering to be held at Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton, Florida, during the **20th Annual International Conference on Engineering, Education and Technology.**

Of importance is the defining of different objectives that have been discussed previously in virtual sessions. Among the objectives is the formation of the National Councils of Deans of Engineering which contribute to the LACCEI Council (particularly deans from Honduras), and a possible Regional Council.

General Objectives

- Facilitate, promote, and establish collaborations for the continuous advancement of education, research, practice and innovation in engineering and technology, based on the recommendations developed by the Deans integrating Latin America and the Caribbean among themselves and with the rest of the World.
- Share the strengths and needs of the Institutions that make up the Council to create collaborative actions for mutual enrichment and overcoming the

limitations for their development, considering the different positions and contextual realities of these public or private institutions as well as their different management models, constantly seeking the necessary empathy and mutual understanding as the key to the desired integration.
