LACCEI and the Observatory of Educational Innovation, of TECNOLÓGICO DE MONTERREY, launch their first webinar in the series "The role of women in engineering and science"

This webinar will focus on the importance of adding experts in the teaching of mathematics to improve education at all educational levels. Professor Ruth Rodríguez will present relevant data that allow us to understand the current situation to better understand this problem in different contexts. She will also share inspiring success stories, as well as tips and best practices done in this direction. PROTECT YOURSELF FOR CORONAVIRUS

- Clean your hands every 20 minutes
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after you've been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with your unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Maintain a distance of at least 1 meter between you and others
- Stay home if you are sick
- Cover your mouth and nose with a disposable tissue when you cough or sneeze, or use the inside of your elbow
- Dispose used disposable tissues in the trash immediately
- After coughing or sneezing, immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 40 seconds
- Wear a mask if you are sick
- If you are NOT sick: You do not need to wear a mask unless you are taking care for someone who is sick
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them using soap and water or detergent before disinfecting
