INTERNATIONAL STUDENT COMPETITION



The International Competition of Student Entrepreneurship and Innovation Projects aims to motivate the entrepreneurial spirit among university students and stimulate the achievement of their academic objectives through the development of innovative entrepreneurship projects.

Who can participate?

Teams of up to four active college students who can be from different disciplines or specializations. These must be endorsed by a mentor professor from the institution where the lead student is enrolled.

Contest Phases

In **Phase 1** is required to write a text describing the project. The authors of the best evaluated works will be the finalists and will continue to **Phase 2**. This will consist of the preparation of a short video presenting the project and a virtual interview with the jury during the LEIRD2021 conference next December.

Recognition of students

There will be four winning teams among the finalists. The first three will receive cash prizes and all the members of these teams will receive free registrations to participate virtually in the next LEIRD 2122 conference. Optionally, they will be able to receive specialized mentoring for the development of their business initiatives. All finalists will receive a diploma of recognition, as well as the institution they represent.
