LACCEI is pleased to invite you to its second exposition of LEIRD 2022, a top-level multidisciplinary event in which researchers, educators and professionals in various aspects and roles in entrepreneurship, innovation and regional development will present and discuss changes, recent trends, challenges, and proposed solutions.

This multiconference brings together academics and leaders of programs to encourage and support those areas, to exchange and share their experiences and research results on all aspects of these topics.

The conference is accepting unpublished papers, including research and case studies, as well as work-in-progress submissions. These can be written in English, Spanish, Portuguese, or French.

Full papers undergo a double-blind peer review and, if accepted and presented, are published free and with open access in the Proceedings of multiple LACCEI international conferences. All accepted and submitted papers are published in these proceedings with ISSN and ISBN numbers and DOI identifiers and will be processed for evaluation by Scopus and other indexers.

Work-in-progress submissions will be single blind reviewed and published in the conference proceedings with ISSN and ISBN numbers.

Unpublished success stories of business incubators, startup accelerators and entrepreneurship support programs written in English, Spanish, Portuguese, or French are welcome. If accepted, they will be presented in a special session and published with free open access in the conference proceedings.

LACCEI PROCEEDINGS in ROR, Google Scholar Profiles, and Dimensions

LACCEI has promoted the generation of scientific production in Latin America and the world since its foundation in 2003. Among other activities, it has established an annual multiconference that presents scientific and academic papers on various thematic areas.

These papers are subjected to a double-blind peer review where the evaluators do not know the identity of the authors and the authors do not know the identity of the evaluators in the process. Since 2016, the proceedings of the conference are published with ISBN and ISSN numbers and are archived with free online access.

The full papers include DOIs and indexing in Scopus. Starting this year, all the articles published in the proceedings will be indexed in the LACCEI repository known as AXCES and in Google Scholar.

One of LACCEI's policy is to measure the scientific impact of LACCEI in engineering, education, and technology through the open access systems, the OpenAIRE guidelines, and the data quality principles known as FAIR Data of the European

Since LACCEI has been maximizing the visibility and impact of scientific production, it has managed to acquire the ROR ID (ROR is a community-led project to develop an open, sustainable, usable, and unique identifier for every research organization in the world) so that LACCEI can be identified as an international research organization. Our ROR ID is https://ror.org/00c959925 and the goal is to enable connections (via consistent identifiers and networked research infrastructure) between research organizations, research outputs and researchers.

Similarly, LACCEI Proceedings are identified in Google Scholar Profiles where we will soon have more than 4,000 scientific articles generated over the 20 years since its foundation.
