

## CALL FOR PAPERS LACCEI 2021



The call for papers for the LACCEI 2021 International Conference will be officially opened on October 1. The conference will take place in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

As is usually, LACCEI will receive papers in 4 languages (English, Spanish, Portuguese and French), in 2 modalities, Work in Progress, of 2 to 5 pages and Full Papers between 6 and 10 pages, in addition to the student papers. All papers should have a limit of 7 authors per paper. The technical tracks are:

### Engineering Education

- Accreditation, Assessment and Globalization of Engineering
- Dual Degree, Certificate Programs and Degree Equivalency
- Engineering Education Management
- Enhancing Undergraduate Education and Curriculum Improvement
- Recruitment, Retention, Diversity, Women in Engineering
- Technology for Teaching and Learning, E-learning, Distance Education, and Online Laboratories

### Engineering Research and Practice

- Biotechnology, Bioinformatics and Nanotechnology
- Energy, Water and Sustainable Engineering
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation
- Engineering Design, Engineering Materials
- Engineering Infrastructure, Construction Engineering, Logistics and Transportation, and Quality Assurance
- Information Technology, Telecommunications, Software Engineering, IoT, Industry 4.0, Forensic

- Informatics, Security, Cybersecurity and Computational tools
- Project Management, Service Engineering, Production Engineering and Product Life Management
- Technology Management, Ethics, Technology and Society

The LACCEI 2021 conference will grant the **"Technology with Social Impact"** award to the authors of the paper and the institutions and/or other entities linked to the investigation, whose development has contributed to the progress of the community in the environmental, socio-economic, or cultural sphere.

Papers can be submitted through our EASYCHAIR platform from November 1.

In the October edition of INNOVATION LACCEI Magazine, the information will be expanded.

## PROCEEDINGS LACCEI 2020

Since 2006, the Multi-conference includes the publication of proceedings on its web page, which are composed of the papers that were submitted by the authors and that were finally accepted for publication. These articles are published with ISBN and ISSN. The full papers also have D.O.I. and are indexed by SCOPUS.

A fundamental aspect in our conference is that the papers must be an original writing and that it cannot be published previously.

The only exception are guest papers from LACCEI partner conferences. These papers are published with a clarifying note indicating that it is a "Republication" and this is done with the consent and authorization of the respective organization and its authors. The purpose of the invited papers is to make their publication with indexing and with free online access.
