Coordinated by Dr. Roberto Lorán, VP of Finance of LACCEI, this November 17 the first meeting of the **STANDING COMMITTEE OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP** was held, an initiative that will be added to the six committees already existing in LACCEI.

The purpose of the Committee is to provide advice to the Board of Directors of LACCEI on strategies to promote entrepreneurship in Latin America and the Caribbean, as well as to serve as a forum for the exchange of experiences between institutions and support collective initiatives.

The committee agreed on a broad line of work in promoting entrepreneurship in engineering, technology and information technology in Latin America and the Caribbean, for which it was decided to create subcommittees in the following priority areas: student competition, organization of webinars, training centers, entrepreneurship and inventory of academic entrepreneurship programs in institutions in the region.

The members of this committee coordinated by Dr. Lorán are: Adriana Fea from the UTN, Argentina; Yolanda Burgos from ITESM, Mexico; Andrés Lorán from UAGM, Puerto Rico, Luis Carlos Arraut from UTB, Colombia, Antonio Ayala Riquelme from UNAP in Chile and Renzo Reyes from UPC, Peru.

At the LACCEI 2021 Conference, there will be a space to present their progress and plans of this important group (More information in the Innovation Magazine, February 2021 edition).

CALL FOR PAPERS LACCEI 2021

We remind you that the reception of papers for the LACCEI 2021 International Conference, which will take place in Buenos Aires, Argentina, is already open on the EasyChair platform. As is usually, LACCEI will receive papers in 4 languages (English, Spanish, Portuguese and French), in 2 modalities, Work in Progress with a length of 2 to 5 pages and Full Papers with length between 6 and 10 pages, in addition to the student papers. Every paper has a limit of 7 authors per work.

LACCEI 2021 will give the "**Technology with Social Impact**" award to the authors of the article and their respective institutions and / or other entities linked to research whose development has contributed to the progress of the community in the environmental, socioeconomic or cultural environment.
